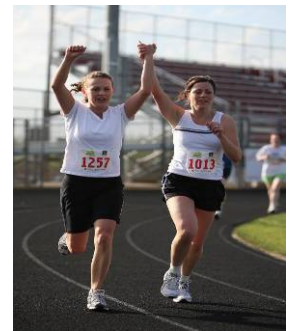

### **What is the Maple Grove Half Marathon & 5K?**

Now in its third year, the event consists of two running/walking race distances: half marathon (13.1 miles) and 5K (3.1 miles). Both courses are in Maple Grove and start and finish at the Maple Grove High School Stadium. In 2009, we added a 2-person half marathon relay.

The Maple Grove Half Marathon and 5K is the only event of its kind in Maple Grove. The mid-May date for the event was selected to coincide with the typical training program for participants in Grandma's Marathon, held in Duluth in late June.

The first year of the event was a smashing success, with over 1,000 registrants! The weather was perfect on race day, and all who participated had a great time. Runners loved the courses, the shirts, and the giveaways. The event filled to capacity immediately again in 2009.

In 2010, we will be capping the event at 1000 participants. We fully expect to reach capacity shortly after registration opens on January 1 of 2010.



### **Why sponsor the Maple Grove Half Marathon & 5K?**

The Maple Grove Lions also support local citizens in need, high school sporting teams, food shelves and other organizations. The club provides many college scholarships for local graduating seniors.

The Maple Grove Lions work actively within the area donating money and time to further our community and make it a better place to live and work.
